PRODUCT USE INFORMATION

AWARNING As a general rule, the taller a vehicle is the easier it will roll. We strongly recommend, because of rollover possibility, that seat belts and shoulder harnesses should be worn at all times. Avoid situations where a side rollover may occur. Braking performance and capabilities are decreased when significantly larger/heavier tires and wheels are used. Take this into consideration while driving. Also, speedometer recalibration is necessary when larger tires are installed. Do no add, alter, or fabricate any factory or after-market parts which increase vehicle height over the intended height of the Rough Country product purchased. Mixing component brands, lifts, with this suspension lifts voids all warranties. Rough Country makes no claims regarding lifting devices and excludes any and all implied claims. We will not be responsible for any product that is altered.

A NOTICE NOTICE TO DEALER AND VEHICLE OWNER

Any vehicle equipped with any Rough country product must have the "Warning to Driver" decal installed on the sun visor or dash. The decal is to act as a constant reminder for whoever is operating the vehicle of its unique handling characteristics. INSTALLING DEALER—It is your responsibility to install the warning decal and to forward these installation instructions on too the vehicle owner for review and to be kept in the vehicle for its service life.

Note to installer: Before installation begins we recommend that a test drive be performed. While driving check for uncommon sounds and/or vibrations. What you feel and hear during the test drive will only magnify once lift kit is installed. Advise you to discuss possible issues identified from drive with customer before proceeding to install this kit.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. NOTE: The instructions show for a lifted vehicle. For stock ride height, instructions will be the same with the exception of the spacer.
- 2. Jack up the rear of the vehicle and place on jack stands. Remove rear wheels.
- 3. Remove the rear bump stop using a 10mm socket. See Photo 1.
- 4. Install the upper mount and 90° fitting to the air bag with the 3/8" bolts using 9/16" socket/wrench. See Photo 2.





5. **Trailboss/AT4 Models Only:** Remove the shielding on the axle using T40 Torx bit. **See Photo 3**. Remove the rear bump stop extension using an 8mm socket/wrench. **See Photo 4** and **Photo 5**.





6. Install lower mount to the spacer or air bag (non-lifted applications) with the 3/8" flat head bolts using a 7/32" Allen wrench and 9/16" socket/wrench. Secure the mount to the axle using the supplied 1/4" carriage head bolts and nuts







and 7/16 socket. See Photo 6.

- 7. Vehicles without a gooseneck hitch: Install the air bag and top mount to the frame using the supplied U-bolts and 3/8" flange nuts. See Photo 7.
- 8. Vehicles with a gooseneck hitch: Drill holes into the frame through the upper mount using a 21/64" drill bit and





install air bag and top mount to frame using 3/8" self tapping bolts. U-bolts will not fit this application. **See Photo 8**. 9. Raise axle and install the air bag assembly to the axle with the supplied 3/8" x 1" bolts, flat washer, and lock washer



using a 9/16 socket/wrench. See Photo 9.

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
