

JEEP 2007-18 JK Hood Assist

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- 1. Remove the rear fender bolt using a 10mm wrench. Retain hardware for reuse. See Photo 1.
- 2. Select the lower strut mount bracket with the tab to the engine side of the vehicle. Then place the bracket under the inner structure of the vehicle and align the mounting hole in the bracket. See Photo 2.





- 3. Secure the bracket using the retained bolt. Tighten using a 10mm wrench. See Photo 3.
- 4. Place the ball stud to the engine side of the bracket and secure using (1) of the supplied 5/16 nuts. See Photo 4.





- 5. Tighten the ball stud using a 13mm socket and wrench. See Photo 5.
- 6. Place tape onto the bottom of the hood below the slot.
- 7. Measure 1/2" below the slot. Using a permeant marker, place a line across the tape.
- 8. Find the center in-between the body lines of the hood. Using a permeant marker, place a line center of the body lines. (for steps 6,7,8.) See Photo 6.







- Use Caution when drilling through the bottom layer of the hood. Do not puncture the outer hood skin of the vehicle. 9. Use a step bit to open the hole to 1/2". Then finish opening the hole using a 17/32 bit. See Photo 7.
- 10. Remove the tape from the hood.
- 11. Install the supplied nutsert into the hole using a nutsert installation tool. See Photo 8.



12. Install the ball stud and 5/16 flat washer into the nutsert in the hood and tighten using a 13mm wrench. See Photo 9. 13. Place the hood strut onto the upper ball stud. See Photo 10.



- 14. Repeat steps 1-13 on the opposite side of the vehicle.
- 15. Support the hood off of the hood prop, lower the hood and connect the bottom strut mount onto the bottom ball stud mount. See Photos 11 and 12.
