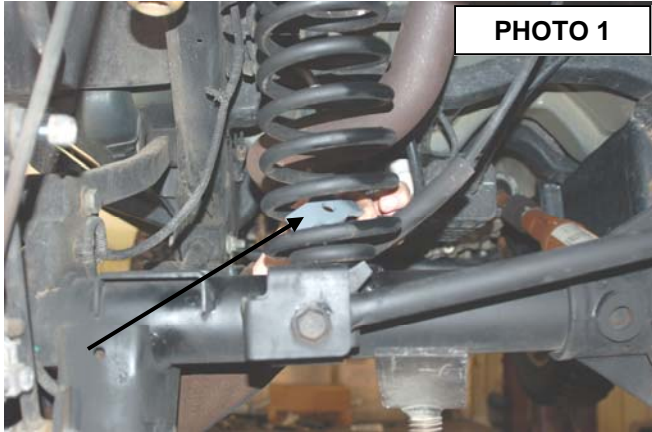

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Install the coil retainer in the coil as shown in **Photo 1**.
2. Install the lower seat flag nut from the front of the axle as shown in **Photo 2**.



3. Secure in place with the supplied 1/2" x 1 1/2" bolts, flat washers and lock washers from the top through the coil retainer in coil seat. **See Photo 3**. Tighten using a 3/4" wrench.



Also available for the rear of the JK Jeep is a Rear Coil Shim kit to straighten the coils on 4"-6" kits. Part # 1113.



## POST INSTALLATION

- Check all fasteners for proper torque. Re-torque all fasteners after 500 miles and recheck after 1000 miles.
