INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Park the vehicle on a flat surface and set the parking brake.
- 2. Raise the hood.
- 3. Using a 13mm socket, remove only the front hood mounting bolt. Retain for reuse. See Photos 1 & 2.







- 3. Install the supplied ditch light mounting bracket, from the rear of the hood, using the factory bolt. Do not tighten at this time. See Photo 3.
- 4. Using a 13mm socket, remove the rear hood mounting bolt. Retain for reuse. See Photo 4.





- 5. Line the light bracket up with the rear hole and install the factory bolt. Torque the hood mounting bolts to factory specs using a 13mm socket. See Photo 5.
- Place the supplied, with the light, light mounting bolt into the light bracket from the bottom. See Photo 6. 5.



- Attach the light bracket to the light (supplied with the light). See Photo 7. 6.
- Tighten the light mounting bolt using a 13mm wrench. See Photo 8. 7.
- Repeat process on opposite side of the vehicle. 8.
- Wire light to vehicle using supplied wiring instructions. 9.
