## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- Disconnect the parking light and remove the existing front fender flares from the vehicle. Retain the stock hardware 1. for reuse. See Photo 1.
- Remove the nut retaining the parking light using a 10mm socket from the OE fender flare and install into the new RC 2. flare using a stock nut. Snug nut to hold light in flare. Do not over tighten as damage to light will occur. See Photo 2.





- Clean and remove any debris from the flare mounting area.
- 3. Install the fender flare onto the vehicle using the stock hardware. Tighten using a 8mm socket. See Photos 3 and 4. 4.





- Install the bulb socket into the parking light housing. See Photo 5. 5.
- 6. Install the lower fender flare onto the vehicle and secure using the (3) OE bolts. Tighten using an 8mm socket. See Photo 6.







- 7. Remove the stock rear fender flares from the vehicle and retain the factory hardware for reuse. See Photo 7.
- 8. The inner fender can be pulled down to access the stock retaining nuts from the back side of the fender while removing the stock screws. See Photo 8.





- 9. Clean and remove any debris from the mounting area.
- 10. Position the fender flares onto the vehicle. See Photo 9.
- 11. Secure the flares using the retained OE hardware. See Photos 10 and 11.
